## 8 'All By Myself'

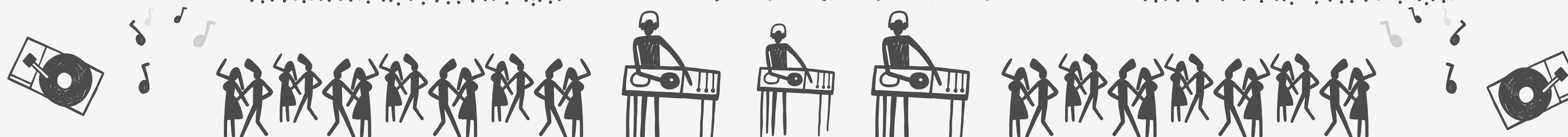
