


Setting up your Harry Headphones



Step one

Set up transmitters and start playing audio.



Step two

Switch the headphones on. Hold the power button until LED power light shows.



Step three

Tapping the power button to change channel. The LED light will change according to the channel.



Step four

Adjust the volume by scrolling the volume wheel.



Step five

If needed, plug Harry into USB socket to charge for up-to 3 hours.



Troubleshooting

Check out the back of this sheet for tips on solving problems that you may run into.

Adjustable headband

Pull to adjust headphone band for comfort when wearing.

b

USB charge port

Charge using mini-USB.

С

Power light

Illuminates when the headphones are on.

d

Power / channel button

Switches headphones on / off and selects channel.



Volume wheel

Use + or - to adjust audio input volume.



Aux socket

Can be used to connect input or use as output.

Troubleshooting'=

No Audio?

- Check your music playing device is working, connected correctly, playing music with volume turned up full.
- · Try a different device and audio cable.
- Ensure receivers / headphones are switched on, connected to correct channel and have volume up.

No Power?

 Check the transmitter is fully charged / plugged in correctly and switched on.

Signal cuts out, interference or reduced range?

- Ensure there is no interference caused by other wireless equipment in the vicinity.
- If using 2 or more transmitters simultaneously make sure each is on different channels (frequencies). You cannot use 2 transmitters on the same channel in the same place. They will cancel each other out, resulting in little or no signal.
- · Make sure the transmitter is in range.
