Note

- 1. When powered on, Bryan pairs automatically with any device that has previouslybeen paired with it.
- 2. Bryan will automatically power off if no devices are connected within 10 minutes.
- 3. Bryan will automatically power off if no operation is performed (or music is paused) for 10 minutes.

Control Buttons

Function	Operation
Power On / Off	Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds
Switch between Modes	Press power button
Clear off old pairing, ready for new pairing (under Bluetooth mode)	Long press Play / Pause button
Music Play / Pause	Short press Play / Pause button
Volume + / Volume -	Short press + / - button
Previous Song / Next Song	Long press + / - button
Answer incoming call / hang up	Short press Play / Pause button
Reject incoming call	Press Play / Pause button for 2 seconds
Redial last phone number	Double press Play / Pause button
Mute / cancel mute (during talking time)	Double press Play / Pause button

Call Waiting:

If there is another incoming call when you are already on a conversation, you can perform the following steps:

- 1. Long press "Call Action" Button for 3 seconds to reject the incoming phone call.
- 2. Short press "MFB" button to hold the current conversation and answer the incoming phone call.
- 3. Short press the "Call Action" button to switch between two conversations.
- 4. Long press the "Call Action" button for 2 seconds to disconnect the call.

Indicator Instruction


LED Indicator	Status
Blue Light Flashing	Waiting for Bluetooth device pairing
Blue Light On	Already connected to Bluetooth device
Red Light Flashing	Low battery power
Red Light On	Charging
Red Light Off	Completely charged

True Wireless System (TWS) Mode

- 1. Turn on your speaker, it will automatically enter into Bluetooth mode.
- 2. Press the (+) and (-) key together for 2 seconds to enter TWS pairing Mode.
- 3. Repeat step 2 on the second speaker to enter TWS pairing mode.
- 4. The LED indicator will flash at slow intervals to indicate TWS mode on the speakers
- 5. To disconnect TWS Mode, press the "Play / Pause" button for 2 seconds.

Aux Mode

- 1. Turn on your speaker, it will automatically enter Bluetooth mode.
- 2. Connect a music device to the speaker using the 3.5mm AUX cable.
- 3. The speaker will automatically enter AUX Mode.
- 4. Short press "Power" button to switch to bluetooth mode.

Note:

Bryan will automatically switch to Bluetooth mode once the AUX cable is unplugged from the AUX port.



Usage Guide

Charging

When the battery is running low, you will hear a prompt tone and the LED indicator will flash red. To charge, connect the Bryan speaker to the USB port of your computer via the provided USB charging cable, or directly using "Recharge" USB power adapter from Over-Ear or any AC 5V-1A power adapter.

- When charging: Red LED indicator light on.
- Fully charged: Red LED indicator light off.

Connect and Pair

Step 1: Press and hold the Power button for 4 seconds to turn on the speaker. The speaker will emit a prompt sound and a blue LED light will flash quickly to indicate that the speaker is in Bluetooth pairing mode.

Step 2: Open the Bluetooth menu on your device and activate the Bluetooth function.

Step 3: Select "Bryan" from the list of available Bluetooth devices (If system requires a password, enter "0000").

Step 4: Once paired, the speaker will emit a prompt sound and the blue indicator light will turn on.



FAOs and Solutions

- Q. What should I do if the Bluetooth speaker does not power on.
- A. Make sure the Bluetooth speaker has been fully charged.
- Q. Bluetooth speaker is not paired with my device.
- A. Try one of the following
- 1. Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode and try again.
- 2. Check if your Bluetooth device is supported by A2DP.
- 3. Your device may be out of range, move it closer and try again.
- Q. The Speaker was on standby for a long time and is not able to boot.

A. The Battery has gone into protection mode, just recharge it before use.

Reset

If the speaker is unresponsive please use the Reset option located next to the AUX port. Using any toothpick or hard pin (please do not use overly sharp objects) press the reset button for 10 seconds.
